\* Maximum of 2 teams per club per discipline (scoring team must be nominated at time of entry.

\* Individuals entries are now accepted

\* A single horse or rider (not combination) can be entered in up to 3 phases, each phase can be contended by different combination (Aimed at allowing sharers to be able to compete)

\* Hats to be tagged and comply to standard

**ETHICS:** This competition is intended as a fun event in which Area Six Clubs may enter teams in each phase. Whilst some clubs do not have a lot of members to choose from, Team Managers should enter in to the spirit of the day and refrain from entering riders who often compete at a higher level in each discipline and so to give less experienced riders the chance to shine.

**ELIGIBILITY:** This competition is intended for novice riders, please respect this when choosing your teams and entries.

Any rider who takes all or part of their income from teaching/training/coaching riders or training/riding/producing horses is NOT ELIGIBLE to compete in any phase other than Handy Rider.

Any rider who has qualified for or competed at BRC national championships in the last 3 years (2015, 2016, 2017) may not compete in that discipline in which they qualified. Eventing includes DR, SJ and XC. Combined Training includes DR and SJ. FoH Challenge includes SJ and XC.

All riders taking part must be bonafide members of the Club they have elected to ride for. No rider or horse may represent more than one club on the day and no rider must have ridden for another club in the current year.

**TIMES:** Will be sent by email to team managers, no later than Wednesday evening before the competition.

**AWARDS:** Individual rosettes will be given in each phase 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>. Team rosettes will be awarded for each phase 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> to each member of a team. Overall Team Rosettes will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> with the Liaison Trophy to the winning team.

**SCORING:** Full details of the scoring system will be published. There will be bonus points for those teams which have the full complement of 4 riders participating. The overall trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring club which has fielded teams in all 4 disciplines.

**VACCINATIONS:** Equine Flu vaccinations certificates will NOT be required for this competition.

**SADDLERY:** As stated in the Riding Club Official Rules for each phase.

**DRESS:** Dress must conform to current British Riding Club rules. Riding hats must be BRC tagged and must be worn at all times when mounted, correctly fitted and secured. Medical Armbands and body protectors conforming to current BRC rules must be worn for the XC Challenge.

**HELPERS:** We must have names and email addresses of helpers on entry forms for the corresponding number entered. 1 helper per team, 1 helper per 4 individuals.

### **DRESSAGE (AM)**

*Organised by Hurst Riders Club*

2 arenas, 1 for Intro C, 1 for Prelim 18 (2002) (Tests may be commanded). In team event, 2 members of team to ride Intro C and 2 team members to ride Prelim 18. Horse and rider combination can enter both Intro C and Prelim 18 (but we may have to limit entries and can't guarantee that they will be able to do intro C before p18). Best 3 scores to count. In the event of equality, the 4<sup>th</sup> score will be taken into consideration.

### **SHOW JUMPING (AM)**

*Organised by Naphill Riding Club*

Show Jumping height 60 – 70 cm. **One round only.** To be run as single phase, so all competitors jump all fences, with a timed final section. Team and individual placings will be decided on faults and time in the timed section (usually fences 7 – 12). Best 3 scores to count. In the event of equality, the 4<sup>th</sup> score will be taken into consideration.

### **XC CHALLENGE (PM)**

*Organised by Berkshire County Riding Club*

Jumps height 60 – 70 cm. All fences will be in contained field. Time section over roughly 5 or 6 XC fences judged on a bogey time. Best 3 team member's scores to count. In the event of equality, the 4<sup>th</sup> score will be taken into consideration.

### **HANDY PONY (PM)**

*Organised by Bicester riding Club*

...take yourself back to your pony club days!!!

Handy rider is a FUN timed 'obstacle course' for you and your horse. The clock will start, and then 10 - 12 obstacles/tasks are to be completed. If an obstacle is not attempted, ridden correctly or completed, 10 seconds will be added to your finishing time. Along the course, there will also be bonus marks (seconds taken off your finishing time) to be had. Clock will stop when you ride over the finishing line. Winner will be the fastest calculated time after deductions/additions.
