Please note you do NOT have to be a member of British Eventing to compete in these classes, they are unaffiliated and open to all.

CLASS 1: Arena Eventing – 90cm Level
Height approx. **90cms** Entry Fee: £35.00

CLASS 2: Arena Eventing – 100cm Level
Height approx. **100cms** Entry Fee: £35.00

SAFETY: British Eventing compliant* XC kit must be worn for the whole competition.
*A British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) approved & appropriately labeled 'Level 3 body protector' with the year 2000 or 2009 shown on the label.
*Protective headwear - a hat that is either PAS 015 or VG1 01.040 2014-12 standard with a BSI Kitemark or Inspec IC Mark, or a similar standard helmet.
Cross Country number bibs to be worn. Numbers will be provided

PRIZES: £75, £60, £45, 30, £15 etc in the ratio of 1 prize for every 5 (completed) starters.
Rosettes 1st – 10th

TWO PHASE COMPETITION

FIRST PHASE – SHOW JUMPING

Speed 325mpm with time allowed Approx. 9 fences

Knock down	5 penalties	Third refusal	Elimination
First refusal	5 penalties	Fall of horse or rider	Elimination
Second refusal	10 penalties	Exceeding time allowed	Elimination

SECOND PHASE – CROSS COUNTRY

Speed 350mpm with a 10 second time window Approx. 9 fences

First refusal	20 penalties	Third refusal	Elimination
Second refusal	40 penalties	Fall of horse or rider	Elimination

There will be an optimum time in this section with a 10 second window

Any time UNDER optimum 1 penalty per sec

Any time OVER optimum 1 penalty per second above the 10 second window

Time penalties will not be incurred within the 10 second window but the ranking will be decided on those with ZERO penalties closest to optimum time

Entries close: 12th July 2017 or earlier if oversubscribed in which case a waiting list will be kept

Flu Vaccination: All horses must have an up-to-date flu vaccination certificate available at the event.

Competitors: must be age 12 years or over at the time of the competition

Horses: must be at least 137cm in height to compete in the 90cm and 142cm in height to compete in the 100cm class
