General Conditions and Rules of Entry

1. No liability shall fall on the Organisers, Landowners, Judges or Officials in respect of any loss, damage or injury howsoever caused and all competitors are deemed to be liable to indemnify the said persons in respect of any such loss, damage or injury.
2. It is taken that online entries have agreed to abide by the rules and conditions.
3. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times. All riders, whether competing or not, must wear the correct headgear with a harness properly adjusted and fastened – skull caps must be worn with a silk. The following hats are acceptable PAS015, VG1 with BSI Kitemark or ASTM F1163 with SNELL E2001 or AS/NZS 3838: 2006 with SAI global. Riders are responsible for their own safety and failure to wear the correct headgear will result in elimination.
4. **All droppings and rubbish MUST be picked up from All Areas and taken away with you.**
5. All horses being ridden on the showground must be **4 years or older.**
6. All dogs must be kept on leads (non-extending) at all times and are not allowed in the Arena areas.
7. It is the responsibility of the competitors to know the rules – our stewards and officials are all volunteers are there to help and advise.
8. All NRC events are run under British Riding Club Rules, a full rulebook can be found at <http://bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>
9. **All entries must be accompanied by payment, and a fully filled out and signed entry form, sent to me, either scanned or by post.**

Points: **Awarded** in each class, towards a Naphill **RC Trophy**, to be presented

At the AGM in the Autumn

Points are allocated when 6 or more entries

6 points for 1st,

5 points for 2nd,

4 points for 3rd,

3 points for 4th,

2 points for 5th and

1 point for 6th

plus 1 point for everyone taking part.

When less than 6 competitors in a class the points will be adjusted

e.g 4 competitors – 1st place = 4 points

1 competitor - 1st place = 1 point
