Pyatts on the 15th September.

You will be entered in the MAIN monthly General Event. Your test will be judged along with all the other entrants in the competition.

I will then sift through the results and pick out the Naphill Members & award rosettes 1st to 6th per test. I will send you your test sheet and e-rosette if you have been placed in the main event, and a Naphill RC rosette if appropriate. You will get Sommerhalder Points for taking part and for your placing as well. This will be a cost saving way of running the e-rider competitions.

This is what **YOU** need to do:-

- 1) At Home in your own arena (or one set up with poles in a field which must be 20x40m. Please make sure your markers are clear and can be seen from C.
- 2) Choose and Practice your test(s) which I will post on Naphill Facebook and on-line.

Go to the main Main HayGrazer e-riders web site to see the monthly short arena tests www.e-riders.co.uk [under ENTER HERE then SHOP, in the categories go to Ring 1-Dressage- 20x40] Please Do NOT enter, just look.

- 3) Send Naphill your entry fee of £12 per test, which includes p&p for sheets and rosettes and **send me** your filled out Entry form (**see attached to this email in PDF and Word Formats**)
Non Members (close friends and Family only) May be able to enter but will not be included in the Naphill placings or receive a Naphill Rosette, but will still pay the Entry Fee of £14 and will appear on the Naphill Results page separately. We will encourage you to join Naphill Riding Club as a member if you wish to take part regularly after 4 events.
- 4) **I will enter you ALL on the E-Riders Site**

You do not need to wear Show Attire, but smart clothes and GLOVES.

If you wear a show or hacking jacket the horse or pony must wear boots or bandages to show the test has not been recorded at a competition. Of course, Correct hats and footwear must be worn and normal BD legal tack, no martingales etc., Whips and Spurs are OK.

- 5) VIDEO your test at C in LANDSCAPE mode with sound ON (Important or you lose 2 points. Ask your Filmer to try and keep you in the centre of the screen and use Zoom at A but do not keep zooming in and out. There must be no cuts or editing to the video and it must start at least 2 secs before you enter at A and continue about 4 secs after the final salute.
- 6) You or the person filming MUST introduce YOU, the HORSE, the TEST and the month you are entering, at the beginning of the Video. If you don't include the Month you will lose 2 points.
- 7) You then need to upload your Video in one of various ways
 - A) FACEBOOK go to HayGrazer e-riders Facebook event for the month you have entered.
(You will need to join the Group page first to be able to post to the event)

Click on EVENTS at the top. Scroll down the events to EMERALD LEAGUE JUNE for this month. Click on it go to Discussion, Then Post in Event. Click on Photo/Video icon and download from your phone.

This is the best way

- B) YouTube- Upload you video to YouTube then post the link on the Facebook Event Page, e-mail it to susie@e-riders.co.uk and cc to me, or send Susie a message on Facebook.
- C) WeTransfer – Upload your video to WeTransfer and send it to susie@e-riders.co.uk. Also send me a link so I know you have sent it to lyn.shew@naphillridingclub.co.uk

8) Now wait for the results to come out on the E-riders Facebook page.

I am sorry that seems a lot but at least you know what to do. Let me know if you need any more help.

There will be more information on e-riders later as new competitions are being added such as a new RIDING CLUB LEAGUE. Watch this space.
