Rules

90 cm Competition is for teams of 4 Seniors or 4 Juniors to jump two rounds each, the best three scores in each round to count. It is also open to individuals.

100 & 110 Competition is for teams of any combination of seniors/juniors & individuals to jump two rounds each, the best three scores in each round to count. It is also open to individuals.

PLEASE SEE BRC HANDBOOK FOR ELIGIBILITY RULES & CHECK RECENT UPDATES.

The order of jumping will be all 4 team members to jump one after the other. We find this is good for team morale and easier for Team Managers & supporters on the day.

If one competitor of a team of four is eliminated in round one, they are permitted to jump in round two. If two competitors from a team of four (or one competitor from a team of three) are eliminated in round one then the team is eliminated. The remaining team members may continue and will compete as individuals only. If entries are large then we will endeavour

to include extra course walks part way through the class.

In the event of a tie for first place, after round two then the times from the 2nd round will be used to decide placings.

This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Rule Book and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook>

All hats must have a visible aqua hat tag in place (BRC/PC/BE approval) before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one.

Original vaccination and /or passports are to be submitted on collection of numbers for each horse taking part in the competition. Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC handbook. These will be checked during the day and any errors may lead to disqualification. There is also a checking device on the BRC website, but if you are unsure, please call BRC on 02476 840518.

The order of clubs will be drawn and advised to the Team Manager. Times will be put on the HWRC website: <http://hwrc.org.uk/times> and also on the HWRC Facebook page on Thursday 28th February.

Don't forget:

All entrants must pay a prelim entry to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual (prelim entries) plus £20 per team and £5 per individual to the organising club, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

Each club will need to provide a helper for ½ day for each team entered in the competition. Please advise contact details with your entry or you will not be allowed to compete. Any club with 3 or more individuals will also be expected to provide a half day helper.

PLEASE ADVISE YOUR CLUB MEMBERS THAT DUE TO PARKING CONGESTION THERE MUST BE NO TIE-UP OF HORSES ON THE SIDES OF LORRIES & TRAILERS. OVERFLOW PARKING WILL BE FURTHER AWAY NEAR TO THE MONUMENT.
