Running Order for 2019.

All Rounds 1 will take place in outdoor arena followed circa 30min later Round 2 in indoor arena. This means the Novice event for everyone should be completed quite quickly. In the event of large entries we will endeavour to put in course walks part way through the class. The order of jumping will be all 4 team members to jump one after the other. We find this is good for team morale and easier for Team Managers & supportors on the day.

Rules

Competition for teams of 4 to jump two rounds each. The best three scores in each round to count. It is also open to individual competitors.

If one competitor of a team of four is eliminated in round one they are permitted to jump in round two. If two competitors from a team of four (or one competitor from a team of three) are eliminated in round one then the team is eliminated and will not be permitted to jump in round two, however the remaining members can continue as individuals.

In the event of a tie for first place, the times from round 2 will be used to place teams/individuals.

The order of clubs will be drawn and advised to the Team Manager. Times will be on the TVRC website : www.tvrc.co.uk on Thursday 28th February 2019 and on HWRC website www.hwrc.org.uk as well as Area 6 FB page.

For a full version of the rules covering this competition please refer to the Official Handbook.

Original vaccination and /or passports are to be submitted on collection of numbers for each horse taking part in the competition. These will be checked during the day and any errors may lead to disqualification. Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook.

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing. There will be a trained steward available to do this on the day if your hat is not already tagged.

Entry fee £100.00 per team £25 per individual. Cheques made payable to HWRC. Entries may be restricted to a maximum of two teams per club at each level.

Late entries after close of prelim entries only if time allows will incur a surcharge of £5 per rider or £20 per team to organising club plus any late prelim entry fee to BRC. Don't forget: All entrants must pay a prelim entry to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above). Entry forms can be found on the BRC website for postal entries www.britishridingclubs.org.uk. Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser

with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual (prelim entries) plus £20 per team and £5 per individual to the organising club, if there are sufficient spaces. Late entries cannot be guaranteed therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been sought.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

Each club will need to provide a helper for ½ day for each team entered in the competition. Please advise contact details with your entry or you will not be allowed to compete. Any club with 3 or more individuals will also be expected to provide a half day helper.

PLEASE ADVISE YOUR CLUB MEMBERS THAT DUE TO PARKING CONGESTION THERE MUST BE NO TIE-UP OF HORSES ON THE SIDES OF LORRIES & TRAILERS. OVERFLOW PARKING WILL BE FURTHER AWAY NEAR TO THE MONUMENT.
