Apollo trophy - awarded for trail riding

Presented to the club by Glenys Raistrick, a very long serving time member both chairman and president. She did a lot of long distance, and side saddle. Apollo was one of her horses.

Barbara Tietjen – veteran horse

Barbara (and Phil) Tietjen lived at 'Hunters Moon' Saunderton. For many years they hosted club shows and training on their fields. They had a very long lived pony.

Phil Tietjen Memorial Cup

Barbara presented this cup after her husband Phil's death.

Wilkinson Rose Bowl – help to the committee by a non-committee member

Pat Wilkinson was a long-time member and presented this trophy. She has now moved to Cornwall.

Kelly Memorial – best turnout

Presented by Frances (Frankie) Kelly in memory of her father. Frankie is now a noted saddler and harness maker to the Royal Mews.

Josh for Fun Shield

Presented by Val Janes in memory of her horse Josh.

Futter Endeavour Cup (now lost as not returned since 2016) currently presented with a substitute trophy to the person who has achieved most on their horse.

The original trophy was presented by long-time member, Jill Futter to reward achievement, with not necessarily the easiest horse! Jill was noted for her success with her Welsh Cob Fred.

Sommerholder Trophy – for the most points gained overall through the year.

Presented by current long-time member Andrea, in memory of her late husband Robert.

Misbourne shield - open show points

Many years back there was a horse-box maker near Missenden called Misbourne Horseboxes. They gave us this trophy.
