Are you interested in riding for the club in the Area 6 Intermediate & Novice Show Jumping Qualifier competition at BCA on Saturday 2nd March 2019?

Info: All riders need to be fully registered and paid up members of Naphill Riding Club for 2019

Format: Each team will consist of 4 members, each team member will jump 2 rounds of show jumps, the first at **maximum 80cm for the Novice**, there is also an Intermediate Competition running on the same day with the Winter 90 starting at 90cm, the Winter 100 starting at 100 and the Winter 110 starting at 110cm

We can also entries individuals, same format 2 rounds and the same starting heights.

Eligibility: Horses must have no more than £175 notional BS winnings. (If you compete in the intermediate competition, you cannot also complete in the Novice competition in the same year)

Cost: The entry fee will be £25 per horse (Naphill Riding Club are willing to pay the BRC pre-entry fee)

So what exactly do I need to do?:

The Preliminary Entries for this competition need to be submitted to British Riding Clubs by the **9th February 2019**. So if you'd like to enter please send me an email asap letting me know that you'd like to compete.

I will also need:

- a copy of your horse's vaccination certificate. (email, post or personally)
- to know your horses passported name & number for the declaration form. (email is fine)
- to know the BS registered name of any horses registered with BS and the amount of BS notional winnings you may have.
- a cheque for £25 payable to Naphill Riding Club (post or personally), or a bank transfer into our club current account (**Naphill Riding Club: sort code 20-40-71 account number 70668605 – please use the reference 2019WINSJ**). If you wish to pay this way please let me know that you have done it so I can keep track of who has paid for what!

Info:

All riders need to be fully registered and paid up members of Naphill Riding Club for 2019.

Format: We can either enter teams of 4 people or individuals at Prelim or Novice Level.

For a Team 2 members will do the 90Q and 2 members the 100Q

The Prelim test is BRC HT 90Q (2013) and then jump a round of 75 cm show jumps.

The Novice test is BRC HT 100Q (2013) and then jump a round of 85 cm show jumps.

Dressage and show jumping will take place outdoors – Please Note some of the dressage will be on grass arenas (See Schedule attached). The SJ and warm up is all on a surface.

In both the Preliminary & Novice one section will be on grass, but please note Rosehill it is a designated dressage arena that is good old turf, not grazed or ridden on outside of competitions and very flat.

Eligibility: For the Prelim/75 cm combo you must not have any BD points BE or BS points. Horses may be currently registered with BE but must not have been placed in the top 6 at BE 90 or completed at BE 100, BRC HT/CH or above in the current or previous year at the close of the prelim entry on February 24th 2019.

For the Novice/85 cm combo you may have up to 225 notional BS points and up to 10 BE points and 35 Elem BE points, no medium BD points.

Cost: The entry fee will be £30 per horse for an individual entry and £30 per team member. (Naphill Riding Club are willing to pay the BRC pre-entry fee of £29 per team or £9.50 per individual)

So what exactly do I need to do?

- The Preliminary Entries for this competition need to be submitted to British Riding Clubs by the **24th February 2019**. This deadline is non-negotiable, so if you'd like to enter please send me an email asap letting me know you'd like to compete, and in which section you would like to be.
- We will need a copy of your horse's vaccination certificate if we don't have it already for 2019 (email, post or personally)
- We also need to know your horses pass ported name & passport number for the declaration form. (BE/BD/BS points & money are always useful to know)

- Could you also please arrange to make a payment for £30 to Naphill Riding Club (this can be cheque, cash or bank transfer, we are not fussy – if you would like to do a bank transfer then please use **(Naphill Riding Club: sort code 20-40-71 account number 70668605 – please use the reference 2019CT)**). If you wish to pay this way, please let me know that you have done it so I can keep track of who has paid for what!

23rd June - Norfolk Holiday

This year's dates for our Norfolk Holiday are from 23rd June until the 7th July.

We can cater for any dates in these two weeks, as long as we are not full.

So you can come for a fortnight or as little as three days.

For those who don't know, we stay on Courtyard Farm Ringstead, the accommodation is basic in a bunkhouse and you can either sleep in the bunkhouse, camp, in your Lorry or trailer, and some members have stayed in a B&B.

The horses have paddocks and there are four stables available on a first come first served basis.

It is a very relaxed atmosphere with lots of food, laughs and time with your horse, although a horse not essential.

There is plenty of off-road riding on the farm and the nearest beach is a half hour hack away, nearly all off road.

The beach is excellent for riding on and paddling or swimming on your horse, it's a mile long so a lovely canter is a must. The famous Holkham beach is a short drive away.

There is plenty of interesting visits whilst there, the Lavender fields, the Royal Norfolk Show, Sandringham, also the driving there, the Seals at Blakeney Point, also lots of lovely villages with plenty of pubs and restaurants.

Costs are: £210 for a week

£380 for a fortnight

Or £35 per night with horse

The cost of the food bill is shared, and everyone is catered for.

A deposit of £50 will secure your place with the balance to be paid by 1st June.

**Friday 5th – 8th July 2019 – Morton Morrell Camp
Moreton Morrell College CV35 9BP**

Arrive Friday afternoon 5th July for three days of riding, coming home late afternoon on Monday 8th. All horses sleep in permanent barn stables, riders in lorries/trailers or ensuite college rooms, we have great, friendly instructors and all riding is on good surfaces. We try and organise riding in twos and threes so we can tailor the work to what you need.

For those who worry about the distance its 64 miles and takes 1 hr 20min from Naphill - with very few bends or gear changes!

It's a grown-up Pony Club camp, offering training, a relaxed social atmosphere and time to enjoy all things equestrian, but with no tack or stable inspections!

For those who haven't been before, the College offers fantastic facilities, with three arenas, so we can plan a varied programme and all work of good surfaces, whatever the weather. The horses will be stabled in permanent 'American barn' facilities and riders can opt for individual college rooms or use their lorry or trailer to 'camp' on site. There will be a shower available for campers and we will all have access to a common room area.

If you are interested, then get in touch and we can send more info and put you in touch with people who have been before.

Down time:

Last year we self-catered for breakfast and lunch; you can bring food with you and use the fridges in the common room and there is Sainsbury's in Lighthorne for top-ups. The college canteen may be also open, we will confirm that when we know.

In the evenings we will eat out in local pubs.

There is always plenty of time for watching others ride, drinking (tea and wine/beer) and eating cake, hopefully while sitting in the sunshine.

What will it cost:

We're still trying to get final costings for hostel rooms, but the horse costs look almost the same as last year, so hopefully the price will not be much more than 2018 (£320 camping. £385 hostel).

Costs do NOT include hard feed for horses, or any human food.
