MARCH NEW EVENT - E-RIDERS ONLINE DRESSAGE

E-Riders Online dressage gives the chance of competing to everyone. Competitors simply choose their Class(es). Please read through the Rules and Top Tips at www.e-riders.co.uk

Enter using the Entry Form and send the payment of £10.00 per test to me, (details on Entry Form) by 24th March. Absolutely NO late entries.

Then video your entry. Allow a few seconds on the video at the beginning, (for the Verbal Introduction) and at the end after the salute showing the moving off.

There is no need for show gear but you MUST wear gloves, approved hats and footwear and only BD legal tack is allowed as in a normal competition – however – the horse is allowed to wear boots/bandages and any coloured numnah.

Once recorded, upload videos by March 31st to YouTube with the link to susie@e-riders.co.uk and me, lynshew@yahoo.com

We are running 2 competitions in house, INTRO A and PRELIM 13 just as a start.

This means that we are creating a show with only NRC members taking part and not open to the public.

TO ENTER

You need to select the test(s) you wish to enter, and you will need to purchase a ticket for each test you wish to enter at £10.00 each

Film the tests in Landscape orientation from the judges position behind 'C' keeping the horse in view at all times.

You must verbally introduce your video with Rider and Horse's names, the month and test ridden stating it's for Naphill Riding Club.

All tests must be performed on a 20x40m arena with all the letters clearly visible and in the correct places. Don't worry if you don't have an arena, you can mark out your own on grass so long as it is the correct size etc.

You will be judged by a BD judge and test sheets and rosettes will follow after the results.

REMEMBER

Wear Gloves, Salute with non-whip hand, do not use your voice. No Editing of Videos

Smile and enjoy. GOOD LUCK

You may enter both classes but be fair. If you normally ride Novice and above then don't do Intro.

Novice and Elementary tests will be included later if this proves popular.

"We will be checking passports for annual boosters and ideally prefer 6-month boosters, or at least the 2nd injection in the case of a restart. In both cases, horses should be 7 days clear of an injection before competing.

Passports **will** be checked. If you cannot present your passport, you will be asked to leave the site immediately."

23rd June - Norfolk Holiday

This year's dates for our Norfolk Holiday are from 23rd June until the 30th June. We can cater for any length of stay within these dates as long as we are not full. So, you can come for the week or just a couple of days, with or without your horse. Numbers will be limited again this year.

For those who don't know, we stay on Courtyard Farm Ringstead, the accommodation is basic in a bunkhouse and you can either sleep in the bunkhouse, camp, in your Lorry or trailer, and some members have stayed in a B&B.

The horses have paddocks and there are four stables available on a first come first served basis. It is a very relaxed atmosphere with lots of food, laughs and time with your horse, although a horse not essential.

There is plenty of off-road riding on the farm and the nearest beach is a half hour hack away, nearly all off road. The beach is excellent for riding on and paddling or swimming on your horse, it's a mile long so a lovely canter is a must. The famous Holkham beach is a short drive away.

There is plenty of interesting visits whilst there, the Lavender fields, the Royal Norfolk Show, Sandringham, also the driving there, the Seals at Blakeney Point, also lots of lovely villages with plenty of pubs and restaurants.

The cost is £210 for a week

Or £35 per night with horse £25 without a horse.

The cost of the food bill is shared, and everyone is catered for.

A deposit of £50 will secure your place with the balance to be paid by 1st June.

Friday 5th – 8th July 2019 – Morton Morrell Camp

Moreton Morrell College CV35 9BP

Arrive Friday afternoon 5th July for three days of riding, coming home late afternoon on Monday 8th. All horses sleep in permanent barn stables, riders in lorries/trailers or en-suite college rooms, we have great, friendly instructors and all riding is on good surfaces. We try and organise riding in twos and threes so we can tailor the work to what you need.

For those who worry about the distance its 64 miles and takes 1 hr 20min from Naphill - with very few bends or gear changes!

It's a grown-up Pony Club camp, offering training, a relaxed social atmosphere and time to enjoy all things equestrian, but with no tack or stable inspections!

For those who haven't been before, the College offers fantastic facilities, with three arenas, so we can plan a varied programme and all work of good surfaces, whatever the weather. The horses will be stabled in permanent 'American barn' facilities and riders can opt for individual college rooms or use their lorry or trailer to 'camp' on site. There will be a shower available for campers and we will all have access to a common room area.

If you are interested, then get in touch and we can send more info and put you in touch with people who have been before.

Down time:

Last year we self-catered for breakfast and lunch; you can bring food with you and use the fridges in the common room and there is Sainsbury's in Lighthorne for top-ups. The college canteen may be also open, we will confirm that when we know.

In the evenings we will eat out in local pubs.

There is always plenty of time for watching others ride, drinking (tea and wine/beer) and eating cake, hopefully while sitting in the sunshine.

What will it cost:

We're still trying to get final costings for hostel rooms, but the horse costs look almost the same as last year, so hopefully the price will not be much more than 2018 (£320 camping. £385 hostel).

Costs do NOT include hard feed for horses, or any human food.

March 2019 sees the launch of the new BRC Five Star Train Together Tour, at venues throughout the UK.

BRC have once again teamed up with world class instructors, this time giving BRC members tuition in the Show Jumping discipline. Professional advice will also be given to the riders with two talks, talking about the importance of clean sport and nutrition with NAF and the Worshipful Company of Saddlers will also be attending talking about tack.

The aim of these training days is to encourage our grassroots rider and to give them the confidence to move up the levels and eventually compete at our qualifiers and hopefully championships!

This is a fabulous opportunity for our grassroots riders to learn from world class experts. Members are welcome to join any training day in any area, as long as they meet the eligibility criteria.

There will be four levels across the day:

Group 1 level 1: Introduction to jumping and pole work.

Group 2 Level 2: 60cm-70cm- Jumping single jumps and short courses at home.

Group 3 Level 3: 70cm-80cm- Wanting/aiming to compete at an area qualifier. Have previously competed at a BRC qualifier but was not placed in the top 6.

Group 4 Level 4: 80-90cm Have competed at a qualifier/BRC championship but not placed in the top 6.
